Read and approve Quarterly Meeting Minutes 08/12/19

OLD BUSINESS

Highway 46 Expansion

President Bill Banfield reported that he had sent a letter to TEXDOT concerning the unsafe conditions at Hwy 46 and Creekwood Pass but has not received a reply yet. Attempting to have signal installed and correct the grade to Hwy 46.

Flow Chart

Paulette Standard presented a proposal for documenting the flow of requests and questions to the POA. The proposal was accepted. Jeff Krusel will develop a spread sheet or other method to keep track of activity and present it at the next meeting.

Unpaid Annual Dues

Marilyn Salazar outlined the current status and procedures. President Bill Banfield discussed 4 possible courses of action:

- 1. Do nothing; maintain unpaid balances on financial records, therefore not allowing a clean title
- 2. File liens on properties with outstanding balances
- 3. Contact mortgage companies of properties with outstanding balances, which is a violation of mortgage agreements
- 4. Post names and amount outstanding in the minutes and newsletter.

Jean also proposed new signs (on the back of existing) for Burn Ban, etc, at minimal cost. Dr Denise Kern moved to approve \$500.00 for the signage. Karla Gilbert seconded. Karla Gilbert volunteered to get an estimate for restacking the rock around the entrance sign, will report at the next meeting.
